So, another sleepless night, rising before the sun. Still dark in that gray kind of darkness that is just before dawn - when something happens. A brilliance that is not like anything that we have ever seen before. We get to the tomb and the stone is rolled way. Coming from the inside of the tomb is the most brilliant light that anyone has ever seen. White is the combination of all colors but this goes way beyond that. It is truly as if not only color has changed but everything - EVERY-THING - has changed.

And it has. Everything has changed. Thank God.
