That is part of the Breastplate (prayer) of St. Patrick. It's a beautiful piece - look it up. You remember Patrick: patron saint of Ireland (although he was neither Irish -a Romano-Briton who was kidnapped by Irish pirates at the age of 16 - nor officially canonized); said to have driven the snakes out of Ireland (although there have not been snakes in Ireland since the first Ice Age); the reason so many Irish Americans celebrate March 17 (his feast day/day of his death) with parades and beer even though the Irish themselves treat it more as a solemn holy day.)

Christ with me.

But do you remember St. Brigid? Her feast day is February 1. She is/was also a patron saint of Ireland, living about the same time as Patrick. In fact, they were pretty good friends. But, being a girl and all, she did not get as much credit or publicity. In fact, I have heard a rumor that the Church un-canonized her (can that really happen?) a few years back because she shares a name with a pagan goddess. (I heard the rumor but can't find any proof.)

The point of all this chatter from me is these are not just saints that belong to some other denomination. They are our saints, too. We need to learn about them and grow from their examples of faith, courage, commitment, and resolve. Patrick overcame his enslavement to pirates and imprisonment to bring the good news to a land that needed good news. And Brigid was a healer, often risking her own health and life to care for someone else.

During this Lent I would encourage you to learn more about the saints. They make our lives richer. Try finding one who has a feast day near your birthday (for example, Francis of Assisi and my Debby share October 4.) Try here: http://catholicsaints.info/calendar-of-saints/


