See? I am doing a new thing. Isaiah 43:19a (NRSVUE)

I have remarked recently to our liturgists, as we stand and look at the Bible before the service starts, how often God says something to the point of, "Pay attention! I'm doing something new!"

And it never fails to make a notch in my brain that we don't really pay attention.

Every so often we are privileged to spend some time watching our grandson near Chicago or our grandchildren in Indiana. At those times I am reminded how much I don't see or hear, how much I miss in the world around me - just because I am not paying attention. To see a squirrel or a red cardinal might not seem like a big deal to us but it certainly is to someone who is not used to seeing them. To smell tomatoes on the vine might seem commonplace to any of us who garden but to someone who is three years old that scent can either be wonderful or awful - but it's noticed one way or another. And airplanes. (I'll confess to this one.) The idea that one of those great, huge contraptions can fly up into the air and fly so fast is a magical thing to some young people (and me!)

The Broadway and movie star, Billy Porter, has remarked that sometimes people get upset because they feel that life is changing when, in fact, it has already changed. While I understand what Mr. Porter has said, I find myself thinking that "changing" and "changed" are not mutually exclusive. Yes, life has changed. I like the comfort of air conditioning and the convenience of microwave ovens and automobiles. I would not want to go back to a time when we did not have those. But I think there are more changes to come - there are ALWAYS more changes to come.

Martin Luther King, Jr. talked about the universe bending towards justice. I agree with that and pray for that. I would also say that the universe is always bending towards faithfulness, too. If faithfulness can be defined as loving God and loving one another, I think we are continually moving in that direction. By and large, cultures and societies are learning compassion, care, and concern for others. Not everyone, to be sure, but more and more people are opening their hearts and minds to those who might be different. Sometimes the differences are large, sometimes trivial. Still, to borrow an image from Jesus, those who are embracing that compassion and care are a light to the world. God's light to God's world.
