

Debby recently asked me, "Why is November called November?" My response was, "Uh, I have no idea." So I looked it up.

In the early days of calendars, before the Julian calendar (named for Julius Caesar, about 46 BCE) and the Gregorian calendar (named for Pope Gregory XII, 1582; the one we use today) there was the Roman calendar - the calendar of Romulus (about 750 BCE ). In that earliest calendar, there were ten months and November was the ninth. Even after the months of January and February were added, November kept its name, coming from the Latin word, "novem" which means "nine".

And now you know WAY more about November than you ever wanted to know.

But there's more to November than that. It's more than football and pumpkin spice and raking leaves and the first glimmers of frost.
November 1 is All Saints Day. It came about early in the church, maybe the ninth century, recognizing the need to commemorate and celebrate the lives of all the saints and martyrs. Then, about one hundred years later, the celebration was expanded to include All Souls Day on November 2, recognizing all the faithful who had not been martyred or canonized. (That includes us.)

At the other end of the month, the fourth Thursday, is the American celebration of Thanksgiving, which is my favorite holiday. There is little hype, little commercialization, little of the grand folderol which accompanies so many other holidays. It is a simple celebration of the bounty that has been given to us by God. We get together as we can to feast, to avoid dinner conversations of difficult topics, and nap. Not being a cook by anyone's definition, I am not involved in the preparation of the meal but I am amazed and astounded by the hustle and bustle in the kitchen while I stay out of the way. After the meal, if I am allowed, I help with the clean-up.

There is a Thanksgiving task that does often fall to me. I am asked to help lead us in a time of reflection and thanksgiving. Not just asking, "For what are you thankful?" Those answers become habitual: food, family, health, whatever. Instead, be specific. What food? Which relative? Which event of health? Or even something else? I will always be grateful for, among other things, my daughter's green bean casserole and jellied cranberry sauce right out of the can. And Debby and the way she takes care of me. And the fact that I haven't had another heart attack.

For what or for whom, specifically, are you thankful? You've got a few weeks. Think about the blessings in your life. Then get in the practice of raising your eyes to the heavens and saying, "Thank you." Even when its not November.
